3. **L14-063 - Caddo Parish, Fire District No. 6 - (1)** 10 mills tax, 10 years, 2014-2023, fire protection, all emergency service, maintenance and operational expenses; **(2)** \$75 service charge, 10 years, 2014-2023, fire protection, and all emergency service.
4. **L14-053 - Calcasieu Parish, City of Lake Charles - (1)** 1% sales tax, 25 years, beginning March 1, 2015, **(a)** construct, acquire, operate and maintain paving, resurfacing, street improvements, bridges, and street lighting facilities; **(b)** construct, purchase and maintain fire department stations and equipment, garbage disposal and health and sanitation facilities and equipment, public buildings, parks and recreation facilities, sewer and sewer disposal works; **(c)** improvements to the lakefront and **(d)** operating and maintaining fire, police, health and sanitation, recreation, public works, and other departments of the City, or for any one or more of said purposes. **(2)** ¼% sales tax, 10 years, beginning April 1, 2015, maintain the salaries and benefits of employees of the City, including, but not limited to the Police Department, Fire Department, and Public Works Department.
5. **L14-026 - Calcasieu Parish, Gravity Drainage District No. 9, Ward 2 -** 14.6 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, maintenance and operation of the District.
6. **L14-025 - Calcasieu Parish, Waterworks District No. 8, Wards 3 and 8 -** 6.24 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining, or operating the waterworks system.
7. **L14-054 - Calcasieu Parish School Board - (1)** ½% sales tax, 10 years, beginning October 1, 2015, supplementing the salaries of teachers and other employees of the School Board; **(2)** 3.50 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, additional support for maintenance and operation of the public schools.
8. **L14-062 - Catahoula Parish School Board, School District -** 5.85 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, giving additional aid to the public schools.
9. **L14-048 - East Baton Rouge Parish, East Side Fire Protection District No. 5 -** 7.5 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, **(1)** increasing manpower, hiring, training, and equipping personnel; **(2)** development, operation and maintenance of the fire protection facilities.
10. **L14-051 - East Baton Rouge Parish, Fire Protection District No. 6 -** 10 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, development, operation and maintenance of the fire protection facilities including the cost of obtaining water for fire protection purposes and fire hydrants.

13. **L14-030 - Jefferson Parish Council** - 1 mill tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, **(1)** ½ of the proceeds to be deposited and credited to the Jefferson Court and Judicial Service Fund to provide, maintain, administer, and operate judicial services in the criminal justice system; **(2)** ½ of the proceeds to be deposited and credited to the Jefferson Community Park and Culture Service Fund to provide, maintain, administer, and operate cultural and park facilities and programs of which ½ will be dedicated specifically to culture and the other ½ dedicated specifically to parks.
14. **L14-031 - Jefferson Parish Council, Ambulance Service District No. 2** - 10 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating ambulance service facilities.
15. **L14-032 - Jefferson Parish Council, Consolidated Road Lighting District** - 3 mills tax, 10 years, 2015-2024, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining and operating road lighting facilities.

19. **L14-060 - Livingston Parish School Board, School District No. 4** - Not exceeding \$25,000,000 General Obligation Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 8%, not exceeding 20 years, **(1)** acquiring and/or improving lands for building sites and playgrounds, including construction of necessary sidewalks and streets; **(2)** purchasing, erecting, renovating, expanding and/or improving school buildings and other school related facilities, and **(3)** acquiring the necessary equipment and furnishings.
20. **L14-043 - Livingston Parish, Town of Killian** - ½% sales tax, to be levied in perpetuity, beginning July 1, 2014, public safety.
21. **L14-052 - Ouachita Parish Police Jury** - 2.90 mills tax, 10 years, 2016-2025, improving, maintaining, operating and equipping the Parish Juvenile Detention Center.

25. **L14-037 - Rapides Parish Police Jury, Fire Protection District No. 5** - 41.66 mills tax, 10 years, 2014-2023, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating fire protection and emergency medical service facilities, vehicles and equipment to provide fire protection and medical services.
26. **L14-038 - Rapides Parish Police Jury, Fire Protection District No. 11, Service Area No. 2** - 45.85 mills tax, 10 years, 2014-2023, acquiring, constructing, improving, maintaining or operating fire protection and emergency medical service facilities, vehicles and equipment to provide fire protection and medical services.

36. **L14-045 - Union Parish School Board - (1) Consolidated School District No. 1** - Not exceeding \$42,500,000 General Obligation Bonds, in one or more series, not exceeding 8%, not exceeding 20 years, (a) acquiring and/or improving lands for building sites and playgrounds, including construction of necessary sidewalks and streets; (b) purchasing, erecting and/or improving school buildings and other school related facilities and (c) acquiring the necessary equipment and furnishings, and especially for those facilities, technology and security initiative set forth in the "Capital Improvement Plan" approved on January 13, 2014; (2) **Parishwide** - 1% sales tax, to be levied in perpetuity, beginning July 1, 2014, operating and maintaining schools and school related facilities, including paying salaries and benefits of teachers and other school personnel.
37. **L14-049 - Washington Parish, Recreation District No. 1** - (1) Not exceeding \$11,000,000 General Obligation Bonds, not exceeding 7%, not exceeding 20 years, construct and acquire a recreational park and facilities and improvements, including furnishings and equipment; (2) 4.75 mills tax, 10 years, 2014-2023, supporting, acquiring, improving, maintaining and operating the grounds, facilities, equipment and programs.
